Research papers undergo editorial review and feedback.

Manuscript Guidelines

- Use **UK English** and **Harvard referencing**
see: <https://www.scribbr.co.uk/referencing/harvard-style/>
- Include a **title, abstract, and keywords**
- Double-space your manuscript with clear headings
- Submit **tables, figures, and images** (copyright free) separately, clearly labelled

Image Requirements

Images must be high-resolution and include appropriate permissions, especially for images featuring children.

By submitting, authors confirm their work is original, accurate, and free of copyright infringement. Accepted work grants *Advancing Education* non-exclusive publishing rights.

House Style Highlights

- Spell out acronyms on first use
- Write numbers one to ten in full; use numerals thereafter
- Use double quotation marks for quotes
